Take Two is presented by three MFA graduates of the Fine Arts Department of The Chinese University of Hong Kong in 2001-2003. They are: LAM Wai Kit, Woody LEE and TSANG Chui Mei. The title 'Take Two' connotes their hopes and adherence about the unfailing drive in art creation.

LAM Wai Kit concerns about the relationship between individuals and surrounding circumstances. She tries to reconstruct images and daily experiences in order to search for the notion of identification. In her recent works, she criticizes the labyrinth between documentary and memory through the appropriation of the characteristics of photography.

In the early years, Woody LEE focused in painting and installation. Consumerism and over-development of cities are the general topics which were presented in his works. Recently, he has been exploring the change of city and how it affects the attitude of human. He captures photos from his surroundings and rearranges these images by computer.

TSANG Chui Mei has been experimented certain fundamental elements of landscape painting, and hopes to create an ideal mental space on canvas. She particularly indulges the positioning of landscape, and attempts to make tension that is created therein as well as triggering off the association in thoughts.

Although all of them have different directions in art practice, they constantly search, chase and act out their live ideas and visions.

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
